Cllr Blaney reported that the barriers at Staythorpe crossing had failed again, the red lights were on but the barriers were up. Network Rail blamed this on Western Power, stating there was an inadequate power supply. Cllr. Saddington noted that NCC would not consider adopting Ayrshire Way. She noted that the LIS scheme was open until the end of February, and that a fund was available to donate toward any V.E. Day celebrations. The footpath at Pingley Lane in Staythorpe is still being dealt with.
